Responsibilities: The site lead worker will be responsible to assure quality completion of work assignments at employment sites contracting with Riverfront, Inc. and to provide direct supports to employees working at those sites. You would train, schedule, call in work time to La Crosse office and supervise workers to assure the work is completed according to the worksite specifications. Site leader worker would also maintain work site supplies and equipment, which would include requisition of supplies, care and maintain equipment; follow development plan goals to support the participant at the work site, problem solve, educate participant in worksite safety issues, administer CPR/first aid when applicable; provide transportation services for participants as needed; assist participants in building natural supports and becoming integrated into their work site.
